माझे ध्येय

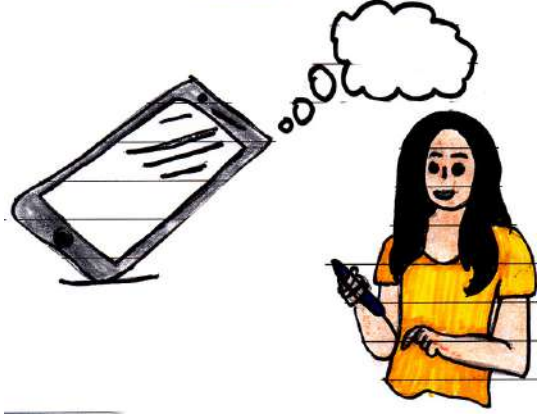
